Cub Scout Day at the Omaha Symphony is designed to provide an opportunity for Scouts to experience a live concert and participate in a workshop with Omaha Symphony staff and musicians. Through participating in the concert and workshop, Cub Scouts can complete the Webelos/Arrow of Light Elective Adventure: Maestro! Scouts should also attend in uniform.

Requirements to be completed during Cub Scout Day at the Omaha Symphony

Webelos/Arrow of Light Elective Adventure: Maestro!

- 1a. Attend a live musical performance.
- 2a. Make a musical instrument. Play it for your family, den, or pack. *(Create a handmade instrument as part of the concert's pre-concert activities in the lobbies starting at 1:15 PM.)*
- 2b. Form a "band" with your den. Each member creates his own handmade musical instrument. Perform for your pack at a pack meeting. *(During the concert, there will be a special, designated moment where scouts will have the opportunity to play their handmade instruments with the Omaha Symphony and Maestro Wilkins.)*
- 3c. Collaborate with your den to compose a den theme song. Perform it at your pack meeting. *(Scouts will collaborate with a team of Omaha Symphony musicians to create an original composition during the workshop. It will then be performed during the workshop.)*
- 3e. Perform a musical number by yourself or with your Webelos den in front of an audience.
