Girl Scout Day at the Omaha Symphony is designed to provide an opportunity for scouts to experience a live concert and participate in a workshop with Omaha Symphony staff and musicians.

Through the concert experience and workshop:

- **Juniors** will meet the requirements for the **Musician Badge**.

Requirements to be completed during Girl Scout Day at the Omaha Symphony:

Musician Badge activities derived from "It's Your World – Change It!" Journey Handbook

1. Explore how music is made.

ACTIVITY: Be a conductor. Scouts will learn about the elements of printed music and practice conducting.

2. Travel around the world of music.

ACTIVITY: Find out about three composers and their music. Scouts will learn more about select composers and their music from Omaha Symphony staff and a guest musician.

3. Check out the music in our life.

ACTIVITY: Go to a live musical performance. Scouts will have attended Omaha Symphony family concert, "The Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra."

4. Make your own music.

ACTIVITY: Make a simple instrument. Scouts will make simple handmade instruments with staff and musicians. *We encourage scouts to complete this activity in the lobby before the concert at one of our handmade instrument stations.*

5. Perform your music.

ACTIVITY: Create a performance. Scouts will use their handmade instruments to perform with an Omaha Symphony musician.
